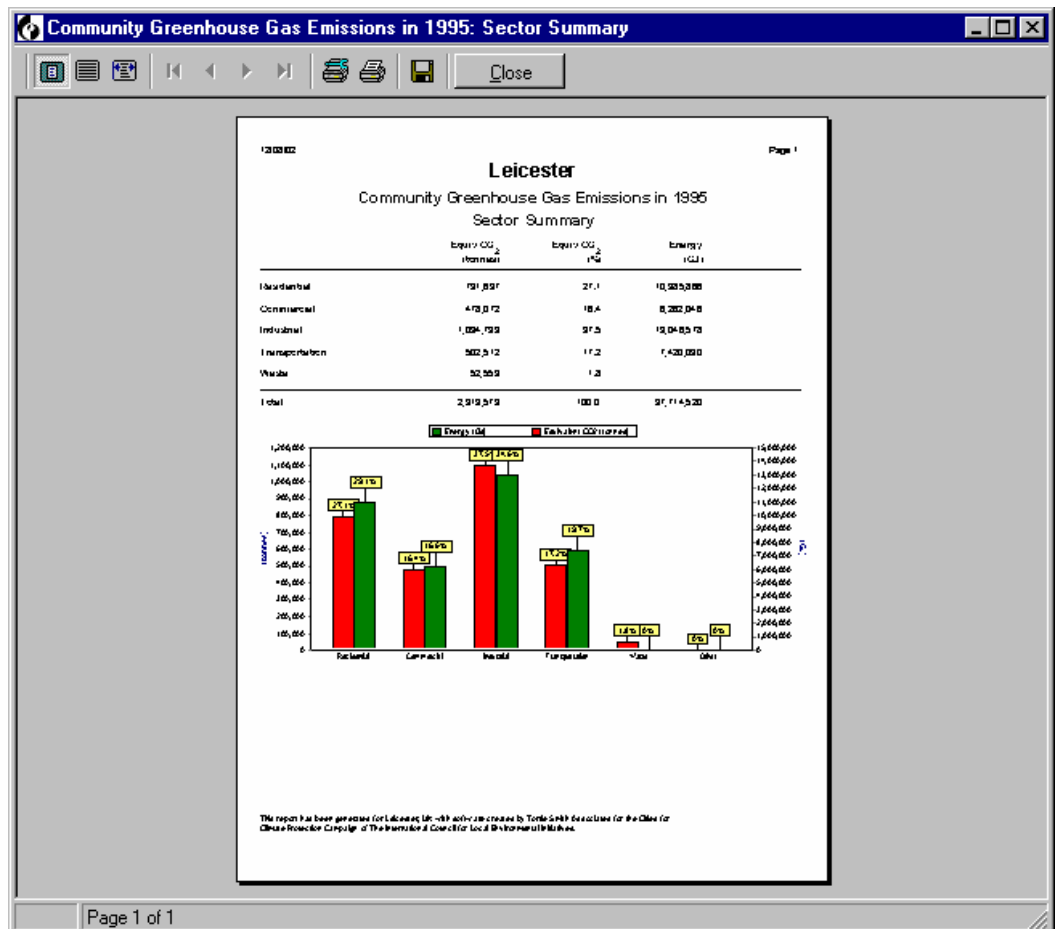
CCP Software

The Councils for Climate Protection Greenhouse Gas Emissions Software

Leicester City Council is one of 24 local authorities participating in the Councils for Climate Protection pilot project in England and Wales. The pilot project is being run by local government's Improvement and Development Agency (IDeA), with support from the International Council for Local Environmental Initiatives (ICLEI) and the Government's Department of the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs. The pilot links with the international Cities for Climate Protection campaign, which involves over 370 local authorities in several countries.

The project uses computer software that can be used to assist in estimating greenhouse gas emissions in the local community and for the Local Authority itself. It can be used to help with setting an emissions reduction target, in considering potential emission reduction measures, and in monitoring progress.

The CCP greenhouse gas emissions software has been used to estimate greenhouse gas emissions for Leicester City Council and for Leicester. The corporate analysis section of the software looks at energy related greenhouse gas emissions for the local authority's buildings, vehicle fleet, street lighting, staff commuting and greenhouse gas emissions related to local authority waste. The community analysis section of the software considers energy consumption in the residential, commercial, industry and transport sectors and greenhouse gas emissions related to waste.
