Locations and Opening Times

Leicester City Council helps to achieve a safe and healthy environment by providing toilets in public areas of Leicester.

- Male and Female toilets
- Baby changing facilities
- Disabled access

All the toilets are opened approximately between 6am and 7am in the morning.

City Centre (winter times: 7am – 6.30pm / summer times: 7am – 8.30pm)

- Newarke Street (under the car park) (7am - 6.30pm)

Others (winter times: 7am – 6.30pm / summer times: 7am – 8.30pm)

- Beaumont Leys Market (closed on Monday and Tuesday only)
- Belgrave Road (bottom of flyover)
- Clarendon Gardens (near the library)
- Cossington Street (by recreation ground)
- East Park Road (serving Spinney Hills Park)
- Infirmary Square (near Leicester Royal Infirmary)
- Foundry Square (by Belgrave Flyover)
- Knighton Lane (opposite Leisure Centre)
- Park and Ride (Ratby Lane)
- Welford Road (Nelson Mandela Park)

RADAR keys

Some of the public toilets provided by the city council are suitable for wheelchair users and are fitted with RADAR locks.
