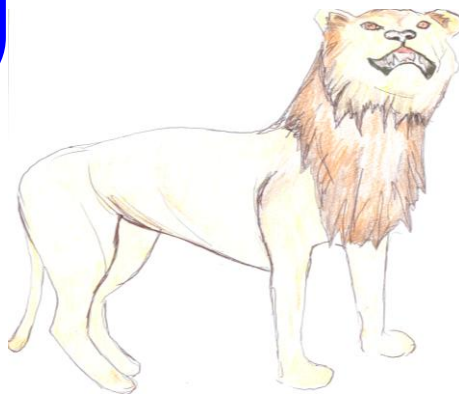

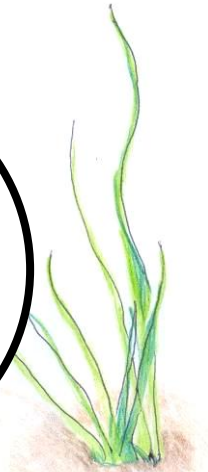
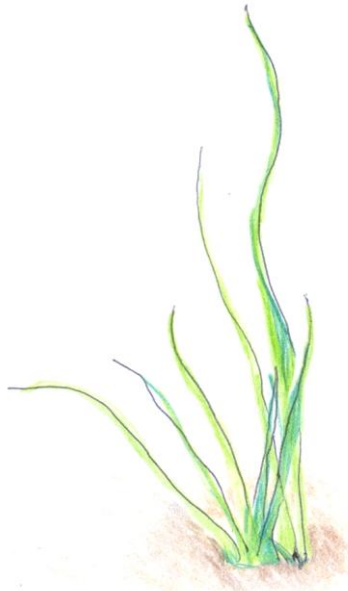

The fox's thick fur helps it keep warm. Its white colour helps it to hide in the snow and to stay safe.

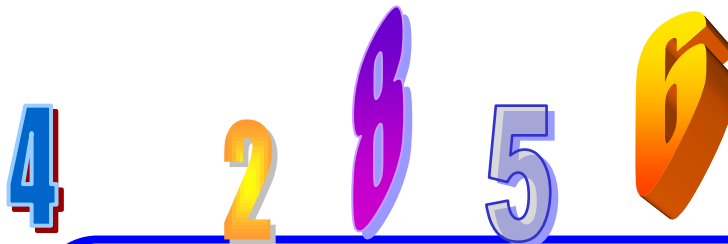
Why do you think his fur is white?

In the Marine Zone, look up to see a variety of birds that live on coastline cliffs.

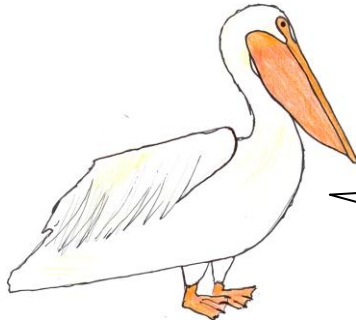

Can you find him?

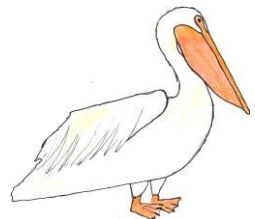
Fact
