

Places will be allocated to pupils who have a statement of Special Educational Needs which names the school as the appropriate provision.

If there are more places at a school than there are applications, every child who wants a place at the school will be offered a place.

Where there are more applications for places than there are places available, priority will be given in the following order.

The over – subscription criteria for allocation of places for entry are: 1st

Children in care of a Local Authority.

(Previously known as Looked After Children).

2nd

Children who are on the 'List of Children Subject to Child Protection Plans' and need to attend an alternative school to avoid the abuser.

(Previously known as the Child Protection Register).

3rd

Children who live in the Priority Area (formerly catchment area) for the school.

4th

Children with a sibling (sister or brother) who will be attending the same school but not in the nursery.

(Sibling includes; step, foster or half brother/sister living at the same address).

5th

Children whose parents are basing their application on religious convictions.

6th

Children of parents/carers fleeing 'Domestic Violence'.

(Subject to verification by a senior Social Worker or current City Council procedures for housing reallocation in cases of recognised domestic violence).
