<p>1. Parents/carers wishing their children to be considered under the faith-based oversubscription criteria must return this form to the relevant school by 4 pm on 31 October 2018. Parents/carers must also complete the Common Application Form for admission to Year 7 and return it to the local authority for the area in which they live by 31 October 2018.</p> <p>Late applications will be considered after all in-time applications have been considered.</p>	<p>1. Parents/carers wishing their children to be considered under the faith-based oversubscription criteria must return this form to the relevant school at the time of making their application.</p> <p>Applications will be considered individually as they are received.</p>

2. In all cases, the form must be signed by a parent/carer. To support the application it may also be countersigned by an Imam who knows the family and/or the headteacher of a madrasah the child attends. If the family's circumstances mean that a suitable Imam is not available, please contact the school. It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to arrange for the form to be countersigned and returned on time.

3. The first page of the form asks for the child's details so we can match them to an application made on a Common Application Form. We ask for additional information to ensure we apply the oversubscription criteria accurately. We also ask for contact details for a parent/carer so we can communicate with the parent/carer easily. Definitions of the terms used in the form can be found in the admissions arrangements for each school.

3. The rest of the form is a religious practice check. It asks parents/carers to indicate the elements of Islamic faith the family practises. This gives a score which is used if the number of applications for Islamic faith places is greater than the number available. In this event, the children whose applications have the highest scores will have higher priority. Imams and/or madrasah headteachers can countersign the application and this process adds to the score on the religious practice check.
