

Maintenance parking permit scratchcards

Terms and Conditions



1. By submitting this application you certify that the information provided is correct. It is an offence to make a false statement for the purposes of obtaining a parking permit and Leicester City Council reserves the right not to issue further permits in such instance.
2. Submitting an online application for the permit does not give you the right to park in the resident parking zone. Only vehicles displaying a valid parking permit can park in the residents parking zone.
3. Leicester City Council reserves the right to make additional checks to confirm the eligibility of an applicant and additional proofs may be requested at any time. Failure to provide these proofs may result in the refusal of the application or invalidation of the current permit.
4. Permits are issued to allow landlords, genuine staff members of estate agents, businesses and charities or contractors working on the property to park in the zone. You may not sell or pass permits to anybody else. If found that permits have been used for any other purpose other than in accordance with this condition, permits will become invalid and the holder/business will lose the right to apply for further permits.
5. The permit is only valid within designated residents parking bays in the zone indicated on the face of the permit. It does not guarantee you a space nor does it give you a preferential right over someone else who is already parked in a parking bay.
6. The permit is only valid if all details on the front of the permit are clearly legible and the permit is properly displayed in the vehicle in accordance with the Instructions for Use and Conditions of Use written on the reverse of the permit.
7. A permit holder must take all reasonable precautions to safeguard the permit and prevent its fraudulent use.
8. The permit must be validated by marking the vehicle registration number in the space provided and by scratching off one panel from each section to show the time and date when the vehicle is first parked.
9. The permit is valid only for the vehicle whose registration number is marked on the permit and is valid for a maximum period of 48 hours.
10. A vehicle may be removed from a parking place and returned either to the same place or to any other residents parking bay in the same zone at any time during the period when the permit is valid.
11. A permit which shows evidence of the registration number of the vehicle having been omitted or changed, or where the time and date panels have not been scratched off, or where additional time or date panels have been scratched off shall not be valid.
12. Only permits issued and displayed in accordance with the council's Terms and Conditions shall be valid. The display of an invalid permit may result in the issuing of a Penalty Charge Notice.
13. Permits remain the property of Leicester City Council and must be surrendered to the Council upon request.
14. Any personal data that you provide will be processed in accordance with current data protection laws. It will be used by Leicester City Council and our partners to deliver and improve services and fulfil our legal duties. We will not disclose any personal information to anyone else unless required or allowed to do so by law.
