



NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS, POLLING PLACES AND POLLING STATIONS

1. Notice is hereby given that Leicester City Council is conducting a review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations that fall within the Leicester City.
2. The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the Parliamentary constituencies of Leicester East, Leicester South and Leicester West will make comment on the proposals and those representations will be published on the Council's website and be available for inspection at the Customer Services Centre, 91 Granby Street, Leicester, LE1 6FB.
3. The Council welcomes views or comments from electors and any persons or bodies with expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability. Local political parties and City Councillors will also be consulted. Comments may relate to existing polling districts and polling places or any proposed polling districts or polling places.
4. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
