

Smartcard parking permit Terms and Conditions



1. By submitting this application you certify that the information provided is correct. It is an offence to make a false statement for the purposes of obtaining a parking permit and Leicester City Council reserves the right not to issue further permits in such instance.
2. Submitting an online application for the permit does not give you the right to park in the resident parking zone. Only vehicles displaying a valid parking permit can park in the residents parking zone.
3. Leicester City Council reserves the right to make additional checks to confirm the eligibility of an applicant and additional proofs may be requested at any time. Failure to provide these proofs may result in the refusal of the application or invalidation of the current permit.
4. The smartcard must be surrendered to Leicester City Council if no longer required.
5. Responsibility for applying for renewal of the smartcard rests with the holder.
6. A smartcard holder must take all reasonable precautions to safeguard the smartcard and prevent its fraudulent use.
7. The smartcard at all times remains the property of Leicester City Council.
8. This smartcard is for use by residents of the residents parking zone to obtain visitors permits from pay & display machines installed in the zone. This smartcard can be used only to obtain permits for genuine visitors or contractors working on the property. It must not be used for any other purpose.
9. If found that the smartcard has been used for other purposes other than specified in the Terms & Conditions, the smartcard will become invalid and the holder will lose the right to apply for any further permits.
10. Visitors permits obtained by using the smartcard are only valid within designated residents parking bays in the zone indicated on the face of the smartcard. It does not guarantee a visitor permit holder a space nor does it give you a preferential right over someone else who is already parked in a parking bay.
11. The smartcard will be valid and charged for from the start date you selected during the application process.
12. This smartcard is not transferable. If you sell your property or move, the smartcard must be surrendered to the Leicester City Council. You may not sell or pass the smartcard to a new occupier or purchaser of your property.
13. Any personal data that you provide will be processed in accordance with current data protection laws. It will be used by Leicester City Council and our partners to deliver and improve services and fulfil our legal duties. We will not disclose any personal information to anyone else unless required or allowed to do so by law.
