6. Introduction

Leicester City Council is taking part in the Green Homes Grants LAD scheme to provide energy efficiency improvements to homes throughout Leicester. This additional Statement of Intent (SOI), sets out the qualification criteria for Solid Wall Insulation (SWI) and Solar Photovoltaic Panels under the Green Homes Grant LAD Scheme Phase 2, which targets a specified area of Leicester City.

In all areas, the final decision on whether any individual household can benefit from energy saving improvements will be made by the scheme delivery partner, E.ON. The signing of a Declaration by Leicester City Council will not guarantee installation of measures or fully funded works, as the final decision will depend on the following:

- i) A survey carried out by our delivery partner, E.ON or their associated contractor and installation costs calculated
- ii) Whether scheme targets have been achieved.

7. How Leicester City Council intends to identify eligible households

LSOA data has been used to identify and target areas within the 30% most deprived nationally with regards to income, employment, living environment and where E, F and G rated properties consist of over 20% of the housing.

7.2 Properties must have an Energy Performance Certificate rating of D, E, F or G, be occupied by a low-income household (individually assessed) and be listed on one of the streets in section 7.1 to qualify. (In exceptional circumstances, Leicester City Council may use their discretion regarding household income and property location.)

Primary Measure: Properties not suitable for cavity wall insulation, which have solid or hard to treat external walls, are technically feasible and would qualify for permitted development rights will qualify for SWI.

Secondary Measure: Where SWI is not suitable a technical survey will determine a properties suitability to qualify for Solar Photovoltaic panels instead.

9. Marketing & Referrals

Leicester City Council will work with nominated partner, E.ON to identify eligible homes which must be either privately owner occupied or privately rented. If a tenant is privately renting, written permission will be required from the landlord prior to the commencement of any works.

10. Evidence, monitoring and reporting

Leicester City Council will use its discretion to decide whether any auditing is required to confirm eligibility under this Statement of Intent. If auditing is undertaken, eligibility of claimants will be assessed by a random sample of households on a post-installation basis.
