THE LEICESTER (CONSOLIDATION) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2006
(AMENDMENT) GRANBY STREET TRO (No.) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Leicester City Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 45, 46, 46A, 47, 48, 49, 51, 53 and 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of this Order will be to consolidate existing waiting, loading and manoeuvre restrictions already in force on the street listed below, by way of amendment to the Leicester (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2006 together with the changes as set out below:

1. Proposed prohibition of driving of motor vehicles except for permit holders and for loading between the hours of 5am to 10am on Granby Street from its junction with Northampton Street to its junction with St Georges Way
2. Proposed prohibition of driving of motor vehicles on Dover Street from its junction with Granby Street to a point 27m south west of its junction with Granby Street
3. Proposed revocation of the existing one way on Dover Street from a point 27m south west of its junction with Granby Street to its junction with Calais Street and introduction of two way along this section.
4. Proposed introduction of no waiting at any time on part of Dover Street
5. Proposed reversal of the existing one way on Calais Street from its junction with Calais Hill to its junction with Dover Street
6. Proposed introduction of a loading bay all days 7.30am-6pm on part of Northampton Square loading limited to 30 minutes
7. Proposed introduction of a loading restriction all days 7:30am-6pm with loading limited to 30 minutes at the existing loading bay on Northampton Street
8. Proposed introduction of no waiting at any time and no loading at any time on parts of Granby Street
9. Proposed revocation of pay and display bays on parts of Granby Street and Dover Street
10. Proposed revocation of loading bays on parts of Granby Street
11. Proposed revocation of a disabled bay on part of Granby Street
