

**LEICESTER CITY COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY EXCEPT PEDAL CYCLES FROM HINCKLEY ROAD INTO  
WESTCOTES DRIVE) EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Leicester City Council HAS MADE an Order, under Sections 9, 10, 11 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act").

The effect of the Experimental Order is to prohibit the entry of motor vehicles from Hinckley Road into Westcotes Drive, with an exemption for pedal cycles.

The Experimental Order will come into force on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 2021, which is not less than 7 days from the date of this notice, and will continue in force until the 28<sup>th</sup> day of July 2022 inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order (which was made on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2021), or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 20<sup>th</sup> January 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Council will consider whether the provisions of the Experimental Traffic Order should be continued indefinitely by a Permanent Order. Objections and general inquiries can be made by e-mail to [Traffic.Management@leicester.gov.uk](mailto:Traffic.Management@leicester.gov.uk).

Objections to the making of a Permanent Order stating grounds and quoting (**ref: Westcotes Drive Prohibition of Entry 2021**) must be received within 6 months of the coming into force of (1) the Experimental Traffic Order or (2) any relevant variation or modification Order to the Experimental Traffic Order.
